A229 BLUE BELL HILL, AYLESFORD TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that A229, Blue Bell Hill Aylesford will be closed to through traffic, on or after 6th September 2021 for up to 14 nights.

The road will be closed between Lord Lees roundabout and Bridgewood roundabout.

Diversion for Northbound traffic:

A229 Bluebell Hill Slip North Off, Lord Lees Roundabout, Bluebell Hill Slip Link Bridge, Taddington Wood Roundabout, A2045 Walderslade Woods, Bridgewood Roundabout, A229 Maidstone Road.

Diversion for Southbound traffic:

A2045 Walderslade Woods, Taddington Wood Roundabout, A229 Bluebell Hill Slip Link Bridge, Lord Lees Roundabout, Bluebell Hill Slip South On.

Times are restricted to 20:00 to 06:00

This closure is necessary to replace the north and south expansion joints. Works to be carried out by Highways England.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
